- Interacts with and supports NKK Regional Sales Managers and Representative firms. Provides leads and new account information.
- Responds to technical questions and objectives and discusses application issues with customers, representatives and distributors.
- Emphasizes salable features, quotes prices and credit terms, and prepares purchase orders for sales obtained.
- Reviews orders shipping for the day to verify correct shipments are scheduled and determine any Credit Card/Funds Transfer/COD orders going out. Interfaces with shipping operator to coordinate information needed to process and/or notify customer.
- Responsible for the biannual stock rotation for authorized distributors. Maintains spreadsheet with all vital information on rotations for the year, advises distributor of dollar allowance, verifies parts/pricing on parts returning, prepares documents, and ensures offsetting purchase orders have been received prior to credit application.
